- Any requests for alternate times for exams must be made in writing to Mr Baines detailing the reason for the request. Requests will only be granted in extenuating circumstances.
- Students are expected to submit all assessment by the due date. If a student has a task that they have not submitted, and the results have not yet been published, they may submit the task before the beginning of the exam period. A valid attempt at a task, although submitted late, may prevent a student Voiding a unit for failing to submit the required 70% of assessment. A reminder that any student Voiding Religious Studies for any reason will be required to complete a minor course in Year 12.
- Exams are compulsory, and any absences must be advised to Mr Baines before the commencement of the exam. A date for resits will be arranged as soon as is practicable.
- Students will be issued with a final absence note. Any absences not explained by the end of exam week will be counted in the final decision on Voiding through absences.
- After publication of the exam results, Year 11 and Year 12 students are expected to attend one session of each subject. This provides an opportunity for teachers to provide feedback on the exams and for students to check and seek clarification of any marking decisions. It is expected that all students attend.
- Appeals only take place after all avenues of review within the Department have been exhausted. Timeframes are strictly adhered to. Full details of the Appeals process are provided in the Senior Assessment Handbook available on the website [About Merici; College Handbooks]:

- **Year 12 students only:** Students may wish to alter their UAC preferences (by Sunday 16 December), in the light of their confirmed ATAR. Students may be advised early of their ATAR by emailing Dr Cleary ann.cleary@merici.act.edu.au through their school email account requesting their score, which will then be emailed to them personally.
